

The Revised B-BBEE Codes allow exempted micro enterprise (EMEs) and qualifying small enterprise (QSEs) that are at least 51% black owned to confirm their turnover and black ownership status with a sworn affidavit.

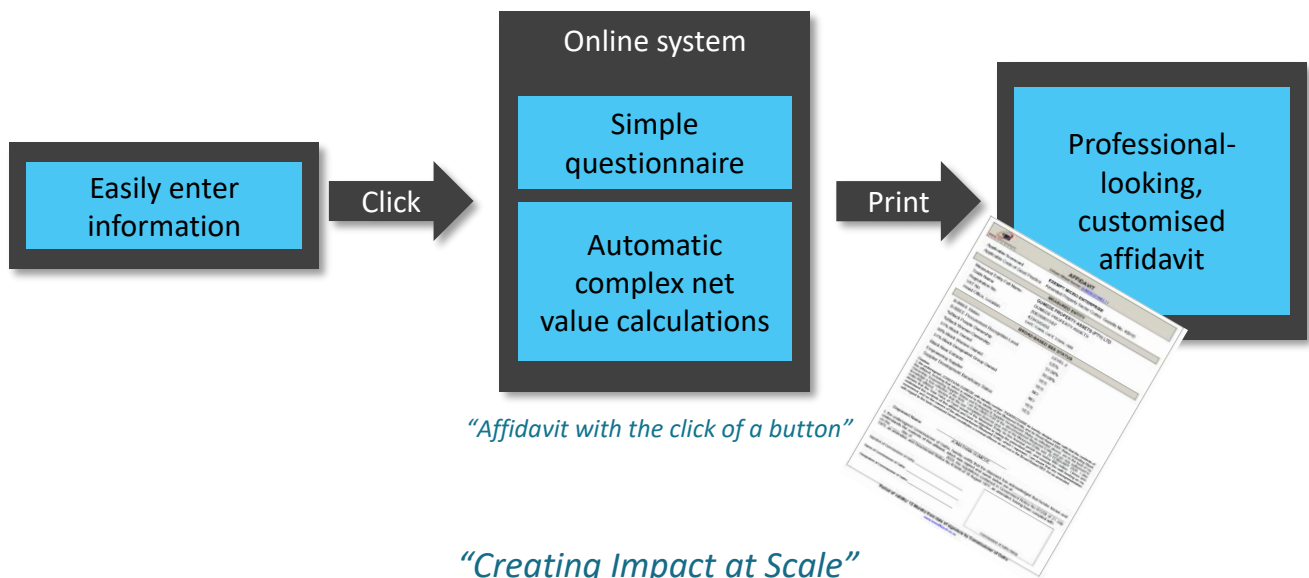
- EME or black owned QSE to effectively determine and declare their B-BBEE Status;

Unintended Consequences

- Decreased reliability
- Risk of inadvertent misrepresentation penalty of perjury to small black businesses;
- Lack of empirical data on this segment of the supply chain of businesses.

Generic Template Risks

- It does not explain the technical terms used to the person making the affidavit.
- It is generic in nature and does not cater for the different definitions and turnover thresholds for EMEs and QSEs in the different sector codes, i.e. not all sector codes have an annual R10m threshold – some are lower.
- It fails to adequately take into account the complicated net value calculations of the business – but rather assumes that the lay deponent is familiar with them.
- When using the generic template, EMEs or QSEs are requested to select a B-BBEE status without regard to the business’s debt structure.
- The generic template does not collect other black ownership detail e.g., black-women-owned status, which could enhance the competitiveness of the business and procurement score of corporate relying on the affidavit.
- The risk of inadvertently misrepresenting the suppliers B-BBEE status is very high.
- Corporates relying on supplier affidavits inadvertently misrepresent their B-BBEE procurement levels.
- Negligent (no intent is required) misrepresentation is an offence in terms of the B-BBEE Act and is punishable by up to 10 years imprisonment and/or 10% of the annual turnover of the business making the misrepresentation.
